Go out into your yard or garden and learn about minibeasts through the following activities and take the opportunity to practise and reinforce minibeast vocabulary in Jèrriais at the same time.

- ₩ Go on a minibeast hunt and see what you can find in you yard or garden (see PowerPoint).
- ** Build a bug hotel. Pile up pieces of wood with old bits of carpet, pottery, pipe, leaves and gravel. Wait and watch and see who moves in.
- * Use information books and the Internet to find out interesting facts about minibeasts. Try Jess' Minibeast Adventures on Cheebies: https://www.bbc.co.uk/cheebies/shows/mini-beast-adventure-with-jess
- ** Read the Very Hungry Caterpillar by Eric Carle (La Carpéleuse Hardi Affanmée) and practise the days of the week, numbers to 5 and types of fruit in Jèrriais (see PowerPoint).
- * Make beautiful butterfly prints. Fold a large piece of paper in half.

 Open it out again and paint half a butterfly on one side. Fold the paper in half and press it together to make a symmetrical print.
