Then ask students “Dans tchi pâraisse qué tu d’méuthes?”/ “Où’est qu’est ta pâraisse?” READING, LISTENING and PRONOUNCIATION DRILL (20 min) Introduce the vocabulary of the lesson in the PPT “les prédictions du temps”. The language is to be repeated by students in order to develop a good pronunciation and intonation. LISTENING - (10 minutes) Play weather bingo. “La lot’tie du temps” SPEAKING - (5 minutes) Information- gap activity. In pairs, students do the information-gap activity. Feedback as a class PLENARY- SPEAKING (15 minutes) On their telephone students look at the weather predictions in Jersey.
