Policy aim

This positive behaviour policy is written with the aim of ensuring every child is afforded kindness, compassion and understanding. To this end the Jèrriais Teaching Service takes a positive approach to behaviour management and endeavours to treat all children fairly and equally.

A consistent approach

In accordance with the Department for Children, Young People, Education and Skills policies and in order to ensure consistency of approach, the Jèrriais teachers will adhere to the behaviour policies of the schools within which they operate.

Jèrriais teachers will read individual school behaviour policies and endeavour to follow each different school's behaviour management systems in terms of rewards and sanctions used.

This will enable Jèrriais teachers to develop positive relationships with the children and maintain an effective learning environment. Furthermore, this will ensure the children feel secure in the knowledge that they are clear about behavioural expectations and the rewards and sanctions they can expect to receive.

Monitoring

The Jèrriais Teaching Service will monitor the effectiveness of this policy on a regular basis. Through regular reviews of the implementation of the policy, recommendations for the future will be made.
